Nevada City CA, is an internationally recognized contemporary textile artist, author, teacher and lecturer known for her

large-scale, painterly designs based on her observations of nature. She works in vivid colors and close-up details of flowers, butterflies, sea shells, fish and fruit to create stunning works of art that have a tactile, three-dimensional immediacy.

Over the past 25 years, Velda's work has appeared in national and international exhibitions and was featured in more than 30 publications, including *The Art Quilt*, *American Quilts: The Democratic Art, 1780-2007* by Robert Shaw and *Quilter's Newsletter* and *Threads* magazines. Most recently, her work was shown in the special exhibition, *Larger Than Life: Quilts by Velda Newman*, at the Shelburne Museum in 2013.

Solid or hand-dyed cotton fabric:

- 1/4 yard dark brown
- 1/2 yard lemon yellow
- 1/2 yard white

1/2 yard cheese cloth

2' x 2' thin cotton batting

purple disappearing pen

sewing machine with regular and free-motion foot

three bobbins filled with cream or white thread

thread to match fabrics

basic sewing kit

14" embroidery hoop
