Double Improv QAYG Table Runner 9 am-noon Martha Oliver

Use basic sewing skills to learn this twist on the quilt as you go (QAYG) technique resulting in reversible designs. Instruction includes basic technique, joining sections and finishing with a reversible binding. Table runner measures about 22" x 44". The project will not be finished in class.

Supplies: Sewing machine, basic sewing kit, small iron and pad, 18" x 24" rotary cutting mat, 6" and 12" ruler, cutter, Elmer's School Glue, 30" x 50" low loft cotton batting.

Fabrics: Choose matching or contrasting fabrics and thread to create reversible runner. Bring scraps and strips of any size, blocks, leftover pieces, or precut charm packs, jelly rolls, etc. enough to fill two shoe boxes—one for each side of the runner.

Arm Knit Infinity or Fringed Scarf 9 am-noon Jill Brandt

Arm knitting is easy and requires no prior knitting experience. Using your arms instead of knitting needles, the stitches are large, so the loose knit scarf can be finished quickly. Learn to cast on, make the knit stitch, and bind off. Choose to whip-stitch ends or add fringe. Project can be finished in class.

Supplies: Two skeins bulky or super bulky yarn (#5 or 6) at least 106 yards per skein in matching or contrasting colors. One skein can be used if it is a minimum of 200 yards.

Template Starch Appliqué 9 am-noon Karen Boe

Learn the template method for hand or machine appliqué. Make smooth curves, sharp points, perfect circles and bias stems. The seam allowance is turned under before you start to sew. Perfect for beginners or for learning a new method.

Fabrics: 12-inch square of neutral background fabric, scraps for green holly and red berries.
